4.	P	A	<b>R</b>	E	S	3rd p. sing. of <i>pare</i> , to trim by shaving or cutting surface away.

9.	<b>B</b>	<b>O</b>	<b>O</b>	T	S	Plural of <i>boot</i> , a heavy closed shoe; 3rd p. sing. of <i>boot</i> , to kick, to dismiss (colloq.).
10.	B	<b>O</b>	<b>A</b>	T	S	Plural of <i>boat</i> , a vessel for transport on or under water.
11.	B	<b>E</b>	A	T	S	3rd p. sing. of <i>beat</i> to strike forcefully and repeatedly; Plural of <i>beat</i> , a rhythm.
12.	B	E	A	<b>D</b>	S	Plural of <i>bead</i> , a small round object, or a small object to be threaded onto a cord.
13.	<b>L</b>	E	A	D	S	3rd p. sing. of <i>lead</i> , to direct or guide; plural of <i>lead</i> , a leash or connecting wire.
