Solutions with Word Definitions

Puzzle 0313: Replace **LAWNS** with a **PITCH** in 13 steps or less.

	L	A	W	N	S	Plural of <i>lawn</i> , a grassed over area, or a piece of thin linen or cotton (lawn) fabric.
1.	D	A	W	N	S	Plural of <i>dawn</i> , a beginning or onset; 3rd p. sing of <i>dawn</i> , to begin to appear or grow.
2.	D	A	R	N	S	3rd p. sing of <i>darn</i> , to repair fabric by weaving across the open area.
3.	D	A	R	T	S	Plural of <i>dart</i> , an arrow or small pointed projectile.
4.	T	A	R	T	S	Plural of <i>tart</i> , a small flan or open pastry.
5.	T	O	R	T	S	Plural of <i>tort</i> , a breach of contract.
6.	T	O	R	C	S	Plural of <i>torc</i> , a solid neckband usually denoting rank.
7.	T	O	R	C	H	Flammable material with a handle; a flashlight; to burn or set fire to something.
8.	P	O	R	C	H	A covered entrance to a building; a roofed veranda; stoep or stoop.
9.	P	A	R	C	H	To dry or desiccate with heat.
10.	P	A	T	C	H	Piece of material used for repair; to repair with a patch; distinct area or domain.
11.	P	I	T	C	H	The angle to the horizontal; a sales presentation; a playing field; bitumen.

	B	O	W	L	S	A rolling ball game; plural of <i>bowl</i> , a dish; 3rd p. sing of <i>bowl</i> , to launch a ball.
1.	B	O	L	L	S	Plural of <i>boll</i> , the seed capsule of a cotton or flax plant.
2.	T	O	L	L	S	Plural of <i>toll</i> , a tax or levy, e.g. to pass a gate or travel a section of road.
3.	T	O	O	L	S	Plural of <i>tool</i> , a piece of equipment; 3rd p. sing. of <i>tool</i> , to equip.
4.	T	O	O	T	S	Plural of <i>toot</i> , a short blast of a whistle or wind instrument, or similar sound.
5.	T	O	R	T	S	Plural of <i>tort</i> , a breach of contract.
6.	T	O	R	C	S	Plural of <i>torc</i> , a solid neckband usually denoting rank.
7.	T	O	R	C	H	Flammable material with a handle; a flashlight; to burn or set fire to something.
8.	P	O	R	C	H	A covered entrance to a building; a roofed veranda; stoep or stoop.
9.	P	A	R	C	H	To dry or desiccate with heat.
10.	P	A	T	C	H	Piece of material used for repair; to repair with a patch; distinct area or domain.

	W	I	N	D	Y	Accompanied by or exposed to wind; flatulent or colicky; winding or curving.
1.	W	I	N	D	S	Plural of <i>wind</i> , a gust or current of air; 3rd p. sing of <i>wind</i> , to coil or wrap around.
2.	W	A	N	D	S	Plural of <i>wand</i> , a thin rod or baton usually held to as an extension to the fingers.
3.	W	A	R	D	S	Plural of <i>ward</i> , a place or person under custodianship, care or guardianship.
4.	W	A	R	N	S	3rd p. sing of <i>warn</i> , to notify or inform of potential or future risks or hazards.
5.	W	A	I	N	S	Plural or <i>wain</i> , a four-wheeled cart or wagon.
6.	R	A	I	N	S	3rd p. sing of <i>rain</i> , to fall as water or in large quantities; Plural of <i>rain</i> , a rainstorm.
7.	R	A	I	N	Y	Accompanied by or exposed to rain.
