Puzzle 0392: Get the **TOOTH** to be a **MOLAR** in 8 steps or less.

	T	O	O	T	H	A hard structure in the mouth used for biting; a projection on a blade, gear or comb.
1.	B	O	O	T	H	A kiosk; a stall or stand; a semi-enclosed seating space.
2.	B	O	O	T	S	Plural of <i>boot</i> , a heavy closed shoe; 3rd p. sing. of <i>boot</i> , to kick, to dismiss (colloq.).
3.	B	O	L	T	S	Plural of <i>bolt</i> , a metal part used to fasten or lock; 3rd p. sing. of <i>bolt</i> , fasten, flee.
4.	B	O	L	E	S	Plural of <i>bole</i> , a tree trunk or main stem of a woody plant.
5.	P	O	L	E	S	Plural of <i>pole</i> , a rod or staff; Plural of <i>Pole</i> , a person from Poland.
6.	P	O	L	E	R	A person who propels a boat using a pole.
7.	P	O	L	A	R	Having distinct poles or polarity; in the region of, or passing a geographic pole.
8.	M	O	L	A	R	A broad tooth used for masticating; relating to matter in a quantity of one mole.

1.	T	E	N	T	H	The ordinal of the number ten; the tenth day of a month; 10% of the total.
2.	T	E	N	T	S	Plural of <i>tent</i> , a fabric shelter used for dwelling or assembly.
3.	T	E	N	D	S	3rd p. sing. of <i>tend</i> , to look after, to exhibit a trend or inclination.
4.	B	E	N	D	S	3rd p. sing. of <i>bend</i> , to curve or shape into a curve; plural of <i>bend</i> , a curve.
5.	B	A	N	D	S	Plural of <i>band</i> , a strip, stripe or strap; 3rd p. sing. of <i>band</i> , to group together.
6.	B	A	N	G	S	3rd p. sing. of <i>bang</i> , to hit; Plural of <i>bang</i> , sound of an impact or explosion; forelocks.
7.	F	A	N	G	S	Plural of <i>fang</i> , a long single pointed tooth.

1.	B	I	L	E	S	Enumerated plural of <i>bile</i> , a noxious liquid usually of animal origin.
2.	B	O	L	E	S	Plural of <i>bole</i> , a tree trunk or main stem of a woody plant.
3.	B	O	L	T	S	Plural of <i>bolt</i> , a metal part used to fasten or lock; 3rd p. sing. of <i>bolt</i> , fasten, flee.
4.	C	O	L	T	S	Plural of <i>colt</i> , a young stallion.
5.	C	O	O	T	S	Plural of <i>coot</i> , a waterfowl.
6.	C	O	O	L	S	3rd p. sing. of <i>cool</i> , to reduce the temperature.

10.	C	H	I	N	E	Backbone or ridge; angle in a boat's hull or between aircraft fuselage and wing.
11.	C	H	I	M	E	Small bell used to produce a musical tone; a sound similar to that of a small bell.
12.	C	H	I	M	P	Colloquialism for <i>chimpanzee</i> or bonobo.
13.	C	H	O	M	P	To bite strongly; to chew vigorously; to champ; a bite.
