Puzzle 0412: Get the **MOTOR** to **DRIVE** in 16 steps or less.

	M	O	T	O	R	An engine; a driving force; a source of motion; motorised; to travel by car.
1.	M	A	T	O	R	Samoyedic language, extinct since the mid 19 th century; Koibal people of Siberia.
2.	M	A	T	E	R	Mother; somebody or something that mates.
3.	M	A	T	E	S	Plural of <i>mate</i> , a friend or breeding partner; 3rd p. sing. of <i>mate</i> , couple or pair.
4.	M	A	L	E	S	Plural of <i>male</i> , a person or animal of male gender or male sex.
5.	M	A	L	T	S	3rd p. sing. of <i>malt</i> , to sprout and dry grain; plural of <i>malt</i> , a product of malted grain.
6.	M	E	L	T	S	3rd p. sing. of <i>melt</i> , to transform from solid to liquid, or (figuratively) to soften.

11.	T	R	A	P	S	Plural of <i>trap</i> , a device or stratagem for catching, holding or hindering progress.

11.	S	P	I	N	S	3rd p. sing of <i>spin</i> , to rotate; plural of <i>spin</i> , rotation or a round trip in a vehicle.
12.	S	K	I	N	S	Plural of <i>skin</i> , outer surface or covering; 3rd p. sing of <i>skin</i> , to flay or to graze.
13.	S	K	I	L	S	Plural of <i>skil</i> , a sable fish or black cod.
14.	S	A	I	L	S	Plural of <i>sail</i> , fabric sheet used for wind propulsion, or a structure resembling a sail.
