Solutions with Word Definitions

Puzzle 0462: Get the **STAMP** to **FRANK** in 11 steps or less.

	S	T	A	M	P	Mark made by stamping; device for stamping; preprinted postage or revenue mark.
1.	S	C	A	M	P	A rascal; a scoundrel; a scallywag.
2.	S	C	A	M	S	Plural of <i>scam</i> , a confidence trick or fraudulent trade; 3rd p. sing. of <i>scam</i> , defraud.
3.	S	H	A	M	S	Plural of <i>sham</i> , a fake or a pillowcase (US); 3rd p. sing. of <i>sham</i> , to fake.
4.	S	H	I	M	S	Plural of <i>shim</i> , a thin piece of material used for adjustment or gap filling.
5.	S	H	I	N	S	Plural of <i>shin</i> , front of lower leg; 3rd p. sing. of <i>shin</i> , to climb a vertical pole or rope.
6.	C	H	I	N	S	Plural of <i>chin</i> , the tip of the jaw.
7.	C	H	I	N	K	An open crack; to make high pitched sounds by the impact of metals or ceramics.
8.	C	L	I	N	K	High pitched sound caused by impact of hard materials; prison (UK colloq.)
9.	C	L	A	N	K	Low pitched sound caused by impact of hard materials.
10.	F	L	A	N	K	The side of an animal or of a group of people or animals; to move in from the side.
11.	F	R	A	N	K	Candid; unembellished; member of a mediaeval Germanic tribe; mark for postage.

3.	W	A	I	N	S	Plural or <i>wain</i> , a four-wheeled cart or wagon.
4.	W	A	I	T	S	3rd p. sing. of <i>wait</i> , to await or anticipate, to serve at table.
5.	W	R	I	T	S	Plural of <i>writ</i> , a formal written judicial or administrative order.
6.	W	R	I	T	E	To compose text; to communicate non-verbally using words.

	F	O	L	D	S	Plural of <i>fold</i> , a crease; 3rd p. sing. of <i>fold</i> , to bend a sheet material onto itself.
1.	H	O	L	D	S	3rd p. sing. of <i>hold</i> , to grasp or grip, or keep or to maintain a position.
2.	H	O	L	E	S	Plural of <i>hole</i> , an aperture or crater; 3rd p. sing. of <i>hole</i> , to puncture.
3.	P	O	L	E	S	Plural of <i>pole</i> , a rod or staff; Plural of <i>Pole</i> , a person from Poland.
4.	P	A	L	E	S	Plural of <i>pale</i> , a fence post, or a region under separate jurisdiction.
5.	P	A	T	E	S	Plural of <i>pate</i> , a human head
6.	P	A	T	E	R	Father.
7.	P	A	P	E	R	A non-woven sheet material; an essay or report; made from or composed of paper.
