Puzzle 0488: Exchange **GEESE** for **SWANS** in 15 steps or less.

	G	E	E	S	E	Plural of <i>goose</i> , any of several waterfowl in the family <i>Anatidae</i> .

2.	P	A	C	K	S	Plural of <i>pack</i> , bound or wrapped collection of items, a group or people or animals.
3.	P	A	C	T	S	Plural of <i>pact</i> , an agreement of mutual support or for joint action.
4.	P	A	R	T	S	Plural of <i>part</i> , a component; 3rd p. sing. of <i>part</i> , to separate.
5.	P	O	R	T	S	Plural of <i>port</i> , a harbour or terminal for passage of passengers and freight.
6.	P	O	O	T	S	Plural of <i>poot</i> , an emission of flatus; 3rd p. sing. of <i>poot</i> , to break wind.

9.	S	P	I	T	S	3rd p. sing. of <i>spit</i> , eject saliva or sputum from mouth. Plural of <i>spit</i> , long thin rod.
