2.	T	E	A	M	S	Plural of <i>team</i> , a group of people working or playing together for a common goal.
3.	T	R	A	M	S	Plural of <i>tram</i> , a vehicle on a light rail operating in other vehicle and foot traffic.
4.	T	R	I	M	S	3rd p. sing. of <i>trim</i> , to cut to size or shape; plural of <i>trim</i> , a piece of ornamentation.
5.	T	R	I	P	S	Plural of <i>trip</i> , a journey; 3rd p. sing. of <i>trip</i> , to stumble or cause to stumble.
