1.	B	O	O	Z	Y	Any alcoholic beverage; to drink alcohol, usually excessively.
2.	B	O	O	T	Y	Involving a large amount of alcohol; cooked or prepared with alcohol.
3.	B	O	O	T	S	Goods and money taken by force.
4.	T	O	O	T	S	Plural of <i>boot</i> , a heavy closed shoe; 3rd p. sing. of <i>boot</i> , to kick, to dismiss (colloq.).
5.	T	O	R	T	S	Plural of <i>toot</i> , a short blast of a whistle or wind instrument, or similar sound.
6.	T	O	R	C	S	Plural of <i>tort</i> , a breach of contract.
7.	T	O	R	C	H	Plural of <i>torc</i> , a solid neckband usually denoting rank.
8.	P	O	R	C	H	Flammable material with a handle; a flashlight; to burn or set fire to something.
9.	P	O	O	C	H	A covered entrance to a building; a roofed veranda; stoep or stoop.

3.	B	O	N	D	S	3rd p. sing. of <i>bind</i> , to tie, restrain, wrap, or cover.
4.	B	O	N	E	S	Plural of <i>bond</i> , a strong connection; 3rd p. sing. of <i>bond</i> , to fix or bind together.
5.	B	O	L	E	S	Plural of <i>bone</i> , part of the skeleton made of calcified tissue; framework or outline.
6.	B	O	L	T	S	Plural of <i>bole</i> , a tree trunk or main stem of a woody plant.
7.	B	O	A	T	S	Plural of <i>bolt</i> , a metal part used to fasten or lock; 3rd p. sing. of <i>bolt</i> , fasten, flee.
8.	B	R	A	T	S	Plural of <i>boat</i> , a vessel for transport on or under water.
9.	B	R	A	N	S	Plural of <i>brat</i> , a badly behaved child.
10.	B	R	A	N	D	Plural of <i>bran</i> , powder made from the outer layer of cereal grain.
