3.	T	A	R	N	S	3rd p. sing. of <i>turn</i> , to rotate or revolve, to change, or to machine on a lathe.
4.	T	A	R	T	S	Plural of <i>tarn</i> , a mountain lake.
5.	T	O	R	T	S	Plural of <i>tart</i> , a small flan or open pastry.
6.	T	O	R	C	S	Plural of <i>tort</i> , a breach of contract.
